

Rock Creek Softball – JV team opens 2-0 with Clay Center

The mustang JV team won 7-6 and 11-6 in their season debut at St. George. The mustangs were host to the Clay Center Tigers. In the first game, the mustangs were led by freshman Megan Srna who notched 2 triples and a single to go 3-3 on the outing with 4 runs scored. Codi Ebert also belted out a double. Paige Miller and Jackie Gonzalez each added a single. The mustangs had solid defense in the outing, including a double play from 3rd baseman freshman Breanna Stillwagon, caught a deep foul ball and then gunned it to Jackie Gonzalez at first to pick off the errant runner. Lauren Leupold notched the win from the mound, while striking out 6 and allowing 9 hits.



In game two Breanna Stillwagon led the offense with a single and a double. Codi Ebert belted out a 3 run homerun in the late innings to secure the lead for the mustangs. Jackie Gonzalez, Ashley McDaris, and Lauren Leupold each added a single. Again, routine out defense from the mustangs allowed for the game to be manageable. Another exciting double play was turned when a groundball to 3rd baseman Leupold (who checked the runner at third) tossed the ball to Gonzalez at first, who then made a perfect throw to the plate for catcher Ashley McDaris to tag the runner out. Caitline' Christenson earned the win for the mustangs, allowing 5 hits.
