

Rock Creek falls to McLouth in regional semi-finals.

The mustangs fell 3-4 to McLouth on Tuesday to end the season at 12-10. The mustangs fell behind early as McLouth scored 3 in the bottom of the first off 2 singles and a homerun. McLouth was held to 4 hits in the game. The mustangs stranded 8 runners in the game, but were able to score two in the fifth and then again in the seventh. Bailey Elliott and Caitlyn Larson each singled and doubled in the game. Megan Srna went 2-4 while Katie Hodges, Becca Snapp and Ashley Srna each singled. "As crazy as it is, we outhit them 9-4, ours were just not as timely or situational of hits as we needed. Leaving 8 runners and many in scoring position was costly. McLouth advanced to the finals to face the eventual champion of the region in St. Marys (4-2). 5 of the teams we have played in our season will advance to the state tournament – St. Marys, Silver Lake, Alma, Riley County and Osage City...that's 7 of our 10 losses, another 2 of our losses come from regional runner ups – Clay Center and McLouth, our only other loss comes from Abilene that finished with a record of 17-3.
