

JV Softball ends season 6-6

The mustangs split with Chapman Friday night in polar opposite games, winning the first 15-0, and dropping the second 6-17. In the opener, Alisha Banta allowed only 2 Chapman hits in the pitching win, while the mustangs had 14, including 8 extra base hits (season high). Ashley McDaris had an outstanding game going 3-4 with 2 doubles and a triple, including 2 RBI's. Codi Ebert also went 3-4 with a triple. Kynedee Hodges, Kerri Briggs, Kelsie Hudson and Alisha Banta each doubled. Morgan Schwinn had 2 stolen bases. Banta and Hudson each tallied 2 RBI's and it was Shauna Severtson who notched the game ending RBI. The mustangs committed only 1 error in the field, and had a very solid showing against the Fighting Irish of Chapman.

Game two, would not be the same type of game, and certainly not the style of game that is a high note for the season finale. 10 fielding errors, 6 free passes and only 5 hits would prove to be the Achilles for the young mustangs. Codi Ebert went 2-3 with a triple. Kelsie Hudson went 2-2 and Heather Gardner singled. Morgan Schwinn had 3 stolen bases. Kelsie Hudson and Brianna Biscardi shared the pitching duties, Hudson took the loss.

The mustangs finish the season with a .500 mark, and have a shortened season due to opponents numbers, cancelling 3 sets of double headers because of low softball numbers. The mustangs made some improvements as the year progressed.
