

Mustangs finish regular season with 2 wins over Rossville

To wind down the regular season, the mustangs finished off MEL play and the 20 game season with 2 nice wins over the Rossville Bulldogs 6-5 in the opener and 18-6 (5) in game two. The mustangs finish 8-2 in MEL play (second) and 12-8 overall. The mustangs began the season 1-5 through their first six games and finished impressively in the last 14 games; going 11-3.

The first game of the double header was a little bit of a battle. The mustangs scored in the bottom of the first and the Bulldogs answered with 2 in the top of the 2nd. The mustangs took the lead in the bottom of the 4th 3-2 via singles from Caitlyn Larson & Breanna Stillwagon to be driven home by Megan Srna. The bulldogs answered with 3 runs in the top of the 5th to go up 3-5. Answering the call in a huge way were juniors Bailey Elliott with a lead-off double in the bottom of the 5th, followed by a 210' homerun, career first by Jessi Snapp that tied the game. Katie Hodges reached base on being hit by the pitch, courtesy runner Alisha Banta eventually scored the game winning run on a passed ball. Bailey Elliott went 4-4 in the game. Shiann Bruce & Kelsey Quinn each added singles. Katie Hodges pitched for the win allowing only 8 Rossville hits.

Hitting 14/22 for a .636 batting average the mustangs put an exclamation point to the end of the regular season winning 18-6 in 5 innings over Rossville. Jessi Snapp and Katie Hodges each went 2-2 with 2 RBI's. Kelsey Quinn belted out 2 doubles with 3 RBI's. Megan Srna and Bailey Elliott each doubled. All 14 mustang players contributed in the win. The mustangs notched a season best 18 RBI's in the game. Katie Hodges picked up the win, pitching the first 2 innings and giving up 2 hits; Caitline' Christenson finished off the work from the mound allowing only 5 hits in 3 innings.

The mustangs followed the double header with a team meal and recognition of senior Jackie Gonzalez. The mustangs will head to regional play at Marysville in games to be played May 16th and 17th.
